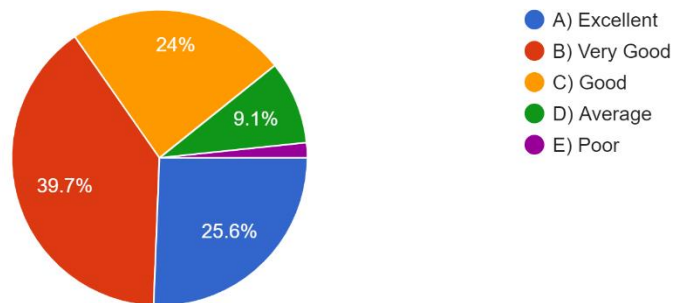

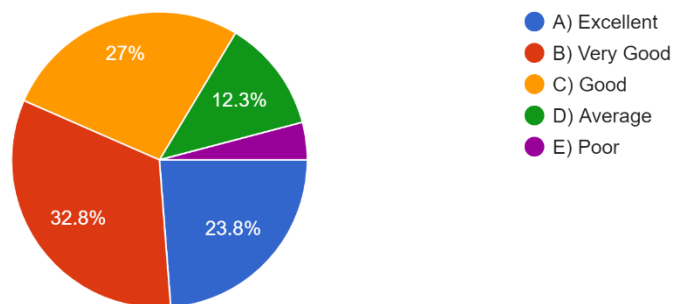
3. How do you rate the curriculum to ensure overall development of the student?

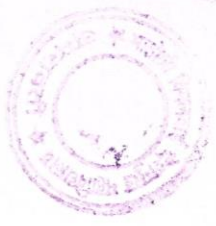




**Action Taken Report: - (2020-2021)**

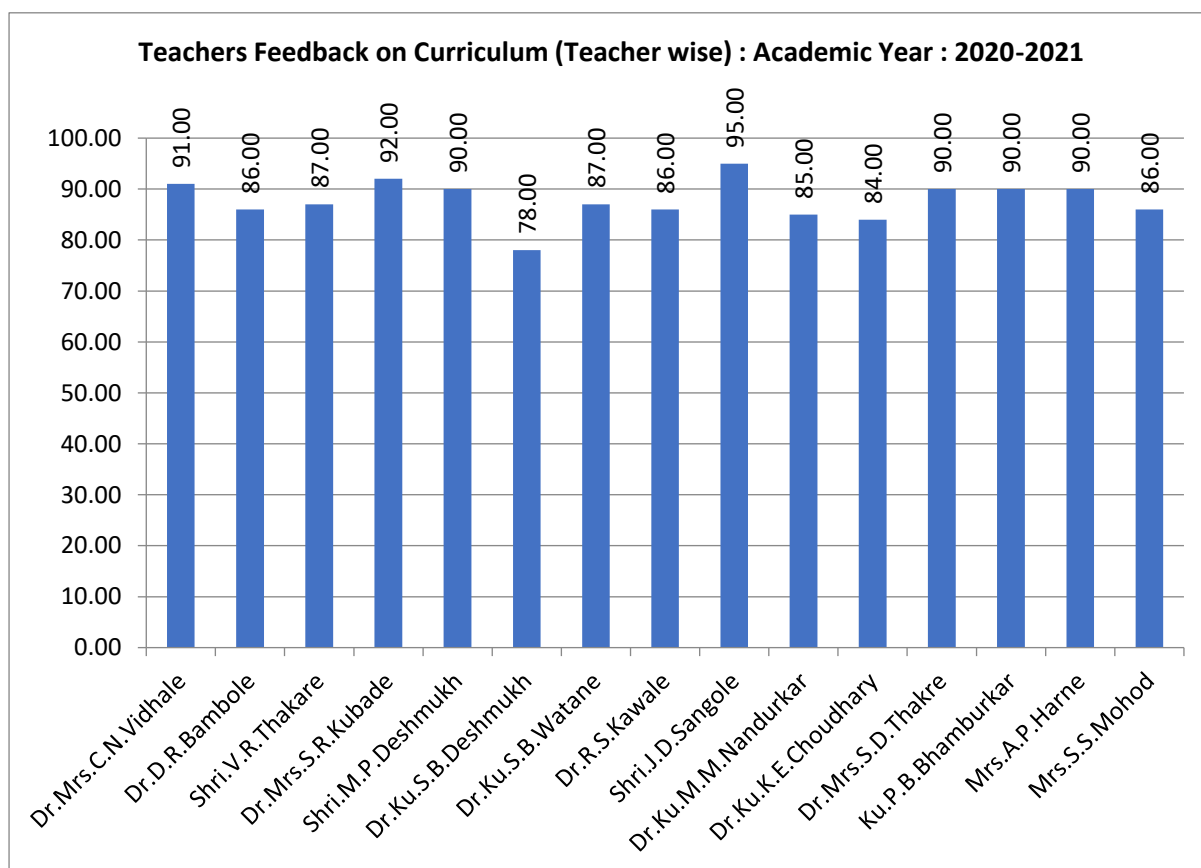

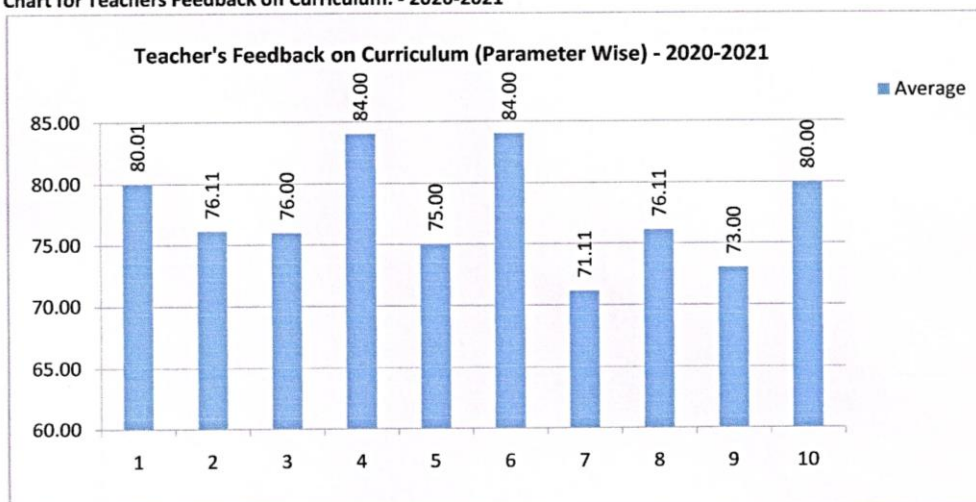
**Chart for Teachers Feedback on Curriculum (Teacher wise): Academic Year: 2020-2021: -**

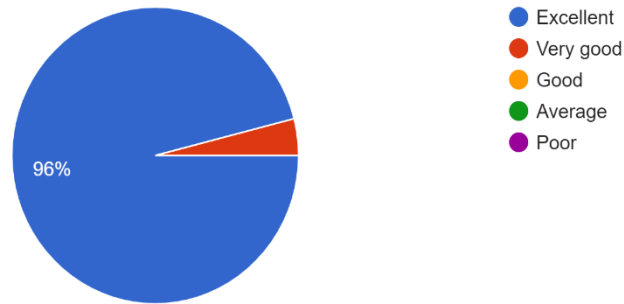


## Graphical Representation of Alumni Feedback 2020-2021



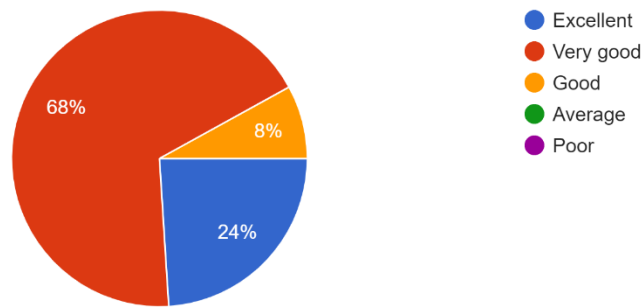

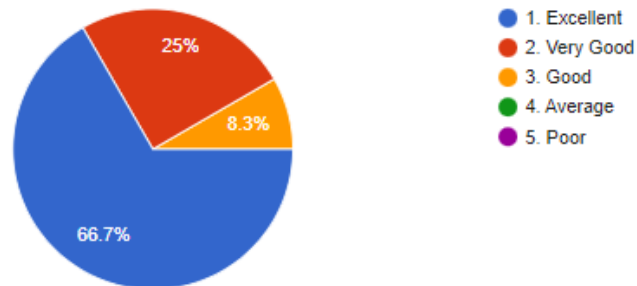

1. How do you rate the programme that your pupil undergoing in terms of the load of the courses in different semesters?

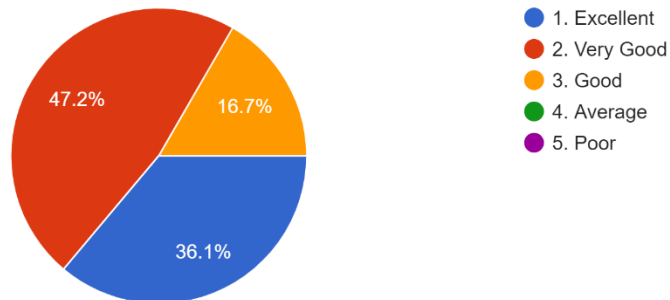

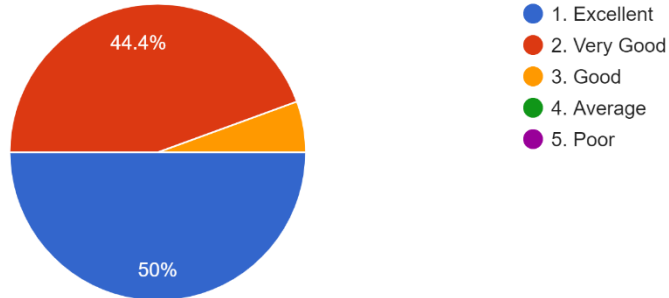

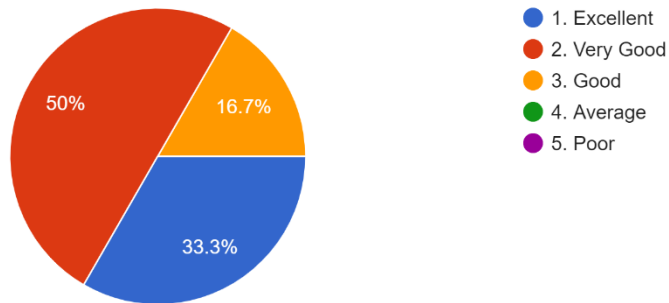

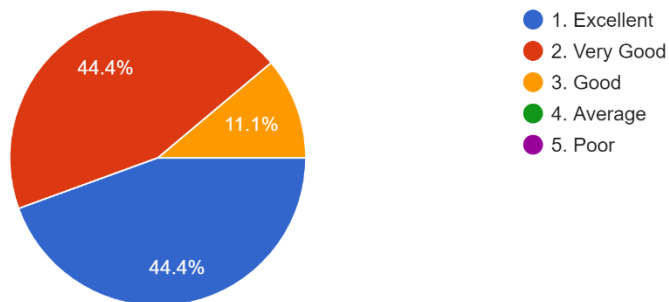

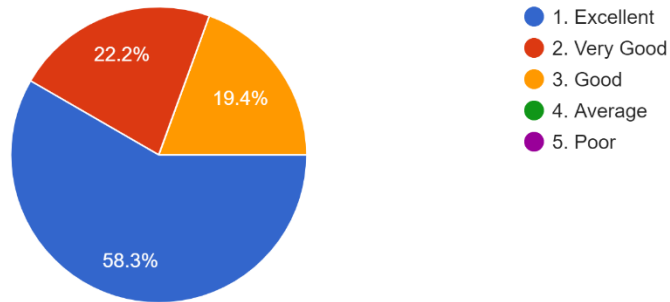

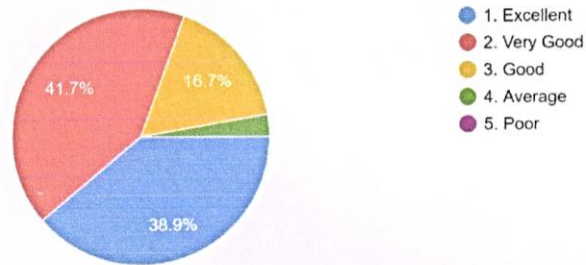
9. How do you rate the transformation of your pupil after the completion of the course ?
