## Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati

The Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati is a premier educational institution of Central India with branches in all the districts of Vidarbha in Maharashtra. It is registered as a Public Charitable Trust (R.N. F/89). Its founder President was the late Dr. Panjabrao alias Bhausahab Deshmukh who established various schools, colleges, hostels and other teaching and technical institutions and devoted all his energy for strengthening and enlarging the activities of the Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati.

The Society was registered in December 1932. In 1958, it had one primary school, seven middle schools and eight colleges. Today it runs 24 senior colleges 54 Jr. colleges, 75 middle schools, 35 hostels mainly in the region of Vidarbha but also in other parts of the state. The educational institutions cover areas like agriculture, arts, bio-technology, computer, education, physical education, engineering, horticulture, information technology, law, medicine, micro-biology and the pure sciences. It also runs a Polytechnic for boys and girls at Amravati.

The Shri Shivaji Education Society was founded by Dr. Panjabrao alias Bhausahab Deshmukh in 1931-32. Along with other members, Bhausahab devoted himself to educate the people by establishing school and colleges far and wide in the Vidarbha. The Society was awarded the Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar 'Dalit Mitra' Award in 1993-94 by the Govt. of Maharashtra. In the year 1999-2000 the Society was awarded the 'Gadge Maharaj Memorial Award. On 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2000. The Govt. of Maharashtra declared the Society as the "Best Administered Society" in the state and bestowed upon it a cash award of Rs. 1 lakh. In its citation, the State Government formally recognized the seminal contribution made by the Society in the field of education and cultural advancement.



## **Matoshree Vimalabai Deshmukh Mahavidyalaya, Amravati**

Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati was established in 1932 with the motto of serving the deprived section of community. The very same objective was envisioned by Dr. Panjabrao Bhausaheb Deshmukh, the founder president of Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati while establishing the College of Rural Services in the year 1956.

Dr. Sarvapalli Radhakrishnan, Chairperson of University Education Commission (1948-49) set up by Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru known as the Radhakrishnan Commission recommended 14 rural institutes in India for rural development and rural higher education. The origins of the institute can be traced back to the rural institute set up in 1956 in pursuance of the Radhakrishnan report on rural higher education. The institute used to offer three years post metric National Diploma in Rural services (NDRS) equivalent to the first degree course of traditional universities.

In 1971 the college got affiliated to Nagpur University as College of Rural Services offering 3-year degree course in rural services. In 1983 it got affiliated to Amravati University, presently known as Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati and introduced B. A, B.Sc (Home -Science) and one year PG diploma in Business Management. In 1999 the college acquired its present name as a tribute to the memory of late Vimalabai Deshmukh. The college is a grant- in- aid institution and has UGC recognition with 2f and 12B since November 1992. The college is located in an urban area on a 2 acres of land. In 1996- 97 the college established YCMOU study centre, Nashik and introduced B.Lib.Sci, M.Lib.Sci and B.A programmes. In 2016-17 B.SC ( Sci) and in 2021- 22 B.C.om(English medium) programmes were introduced on non- grant basis.

In 2021- 22 Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati approved 06 Ph.D centres .The institute is NAAC re-accredited twice (B grade in second cycle and A with 3.19 CGPA in third cycle). It also participated in assessment from National bodies like NIRF. It is also certified with ISO-9001:2015

The strength of the institute is highly qualified and motivated staff. The library is rich enough to fulfill the requirements of all the stakeholders. The institute has NSS and NCC unit.

### **Admission Procedure:**

The programme for admission for the current session will be displayed on the Notice Board/college website- [www.mvdcollege.org](http://www.mvdcollege.org) Applicants are advised to keep themselves informed of the various notices that are displayed on the Notice Board/college website from time to time.

Admissions are subject to the eligibility norms of the S.G.B. Amravati University, Amravati. At the time of admission students have to bring a printout of submitted application form along with the attested copies of following documents as well as the original documents for verification:

- i) School / College Leaving Certificate (T.C.)
- ii) Statement of marks of the last examination passed/failed.
- iii) Migration Certificate in case of a student who has passed the last examination from a Board other than Maharashtra State Board or a University other than S.G.B. Amravati University.
- iv) Caste certificate, Validity and Non- Creamy Layer.
- v) Aadhar Card

- Students who pass the qualifying examination from any other University and desire to seek admission should submit an eligibility certificate.
- Applicants who have a break in education should submit a gap certificate in the form of a court affidavit stating the reason for the gap.
- Applicants will be required to surrender the original copy of their School/College leaving certificate at the time of finalisation of admission.
- Duplicate T.C. (Transfer Certificate) will not be entertained.
- Admission will be provisional, subject to the approval of the University, and is liable to be cancelled at any time if the applicant has given false information, or University enrolment is not given to him/her.
- Reservation of seats for candidates belonging to backward classes will be according to the government regulations and circulars.
- All matters related to admission will be handled by the admission committee. Applicants are required to contact this committee during working hours as displayed on the Notice Board.
- The Principal may amend the admission rules at his/her discretion. The Principal's decision in all matters related to admission shall be final. For details, contact the Admission Committee.

### Scholarships/Concessions/Incentives

Applicants from Scheduled Castes, Various Backward Classes and Economically Backward Classes who have secured and confirmed their final admissions can avail the benefit under State Government various Scholarships/Freeships schemes etc. by applying online through State Government <https://mahadbt.maharashtra.gov.in/portal> For availing the prescribed benefit of scholarship/Freeship schemes etc. The candidate must fulfill the scheme eligibility and submit online application through Maha-DBT portal within one month from the date of securing final admission in the college/institution.

A.1) After taking admission, the application for the educational concessions for which you are eligible should be submitted to the office within 15 days along with the necessary documents.

Students who are eligible for the Government of India scholarship, must attach documents such as T.C., Mark sheet, Caste proof attested Xerox copy.

2) Documents like Income proof of the same Tehsil in which the student is a resident, order number of scholarship taken earlier etc. are necessary to attached.

3) Income limit for Scholarship Eligible Students in V. J., N.T., S.B.C., O.B.C. category is Rs.1 lakh.

4) Income limit for Scholarship Eligible Students in S.C., S.T. category is Rs.2 Lakh

5) Students who are eligible for the scholarship but whose income is more than Rs.1 lakh and Rs.2 lakhs should fill the Freeship Scholarship Application Form.

6) For O.B.C., S.B.C., V.J., N. T. students must attach the Non-Criminal Certificate along with the Free- ship application along with the order number of the previous relaxation.



7) For students availing E.B.C. concession, their father's income should not exceed Rs.8 lakhs.

8) Students who are eligible for E.B.C. concession should attach two Xerox copies of front and back page of rationing card along with E.B.C. application and bring original rationing card for verification, otherwise E. B. C. application will not be accepted.

9) It is mandatory to attach the rationing card and Tehsil proof of the same address as the permanent address on the admission form of the students. If any discrepancy is found, the application will not be accepted.

10) Students should clearly note that 75% attendance is required from admission for Scholarship, E.B.C. or Freeship Scholarship. Students should clearly note that otherwise they will not be eligible for any of the above educational concessions.

**B)** Children of freedom fighters and children of army recruits will get financial concessions from the Government of Maharashtra.

**C)** National Loan Scholarship will be available to merit students. The University has passed an Ordinance to provide incentive marks for college students of all branches for extra-curricular courses such as National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.), National Service Scheme (N.S.S.), Games and Sports and oratorical, Drama, Music Competitions etc.

The objective of this Ordinance is to encourage the student to participate more vigorously in the above-mentioned extracurricular programs and to obtain more creditable marks in his examination mark sheet. This estimate Ordinance has come into effect from Summer Examination 1986. A maximum of ten incentive marks are awarded to a student for one or all of these extracurricular programs directed above. Incentive marks are awarded by securing a maximum of five percent marks in one subject or all subjects below the pass mark and/or get credit in full marks.



### **Incentive marks for graduate students will be awarded as follows:**

- 1) (a) Participation in the National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.) throughout the year -5 Marks
- (b) Passed B Certificate Examination - 2 Marks
- (c) Passed C Certificate Examination- 2 Marks
- (d) Selection for Republic Day Conduct- 3 Marks

## Documents Required for Admission

At the time of admission student has to bring a printout of submitted application form the attested copies of following documents as well as the original documents for verification:

- i. School /College Leaving Certificate (T.C.)
- ii. Statement of marks of the last examination passed/failed.
- iii. Migration Certificate in case of a student who has passed the last examination from a Board other than Maharashtra State Board or a University other than S.G.B. Amravati University.
- iv. Caste certificate, Validity and Non Creamy Layer.
- v. Aadhar Card

### Reservation Criteria:

Reservation policy of the Government of Maharashtra will be followed.

An applicant belonging to backward category will be required to submit the original caste certificate, caste validity & non creamy layer issued by the competent authority at the time of admission.

### Other Instructions:

- At the time of admission, the applicant must produce the original leaving certificate /Transfer certificate of the institute last attended. Duplicate T.C. will not be entertained. If any of the statements made in the application form or any information supplied by the applicant in connection with his/her admission is found to be false/incorrect, his/her admission will be cancelled, and the fees forfeited.
- Students of other university should submit a migration certificate on or before 15th September, signed by the Registrar of the University from which they have migrated, and pay an immigration fee.
- For study tours and educational visits, students will have to pay the educational tour expenses separately.

## Rules & Regulations and code of conduct for students

- Read the prospectus carefully for proper information.
- The candidates will have to pay all fees within the prescribed date.
- In case a student does not deposit fees by that date, his/her admission will be treated as cancelled.
- Students who cancel admission at any time for any reason shall have to pay tuition fees & other fees as per University rules.
- No certificate of any kind will be issued unless full session fees are paid. Any amount paid by the student at the time of admission and later will not be refunded.
- All new entrants will have to enroll themselves in the University. A prescribed form for this purpose will be supplied by the college in due course of time or on the date prescribed by the University. Students who fail to fill in the form shall be responsible for any action taken by appropriate authorities.
- Students shall have to obey all the instructions of the Principal. They will be answerable to him for their behaviour in general, both inside and outside the college. Students found violating the rules of the college administration or behaving in an indiscipline manner will be expelled from the college. It will be presumed on admission that the students concerned and their parents and/or guardians have read and concurred with these rules.
- Students should behave respectfully with all staff members at college and politely with their fellow students, including girls. Any act of disobedience, improper and discourteous exchange of words or indecent remarks, especially at girl students, is a punishable offence and will be viewed seriously.
- The prescribed uniform for girls & boys is compulsory.
- Students should make careful use of college books, room furniture, fans, laboratory equipment and college property in general. The cost of damage



done to it would be recoverable from students either individually or collectively as the case may be. Only special notices shall be read out in the classroom, Students, therefore, should see the notice board daily and keep themselves well informed about the various notices that may be put up there from time to time.

- No student shall send any information concerning the college for publication either to the press or elsewhere without prior approval of the Principal of the college, nor shall he/she approach the President or the L.M.C. Members except through the college Principal. Any breach of this rule may lead to outright expulsion of the student from the college.
- The students should not roam in corridors, or play during working hours or free classes, Instead, they should utilise the library and reading room facilities.
- Smoking, gutka/paan chewing and ragging are strictly prohibited. Offenders are liable to face legal action.
- Students are prohibited from forming associations/organisations and from holding functions in the college without the prior permission of the Principal.
- Students are prohibited from organising welcome and farewell and other such functions outside college premises. Violation shall attract severe disciplinary action.
- Any change of address must be notified to the college office immediately. For details of the curriculum refer to the syllabi of the Education Board/University, as the case may be.

### **Special notice to students regarding ragging:**

In order to prevent the unfortunate occurrence of ragging in any colleges in the future, the Government has enacted the Anti-Ragging Maharashtra Prevention of Ragging Act 1999 (Act No. 33 of 99).

Meaning of the term ragging - Exhibits misbehaviour or commits any such act which causes or is likely to cause physical or mental harm to a student in any educational institution or causes him to feel fear or dread or embarrassment or there is a feeling of being in trouble.

And that includes the following

A) Teasing, abusing, threatening, or playing pranks or saying hurtful words on such a student.

Or

B) Asking such student to do an act or thing which he would not ordinarily do academically.

\* Ragging is prohibited in or outside any educational institution.

\* Whoever directly or indirectly participates in, encourages or promotes ragging in or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to 02 years and with fine which may extend to 10,000/- rupees.

Besides that, the offending student will be expelled from the college or institution and he will not get admission in any other colleges or institute for five years.

Students are requested not to engage in such misbehaviour.

- 5) Adhar Card of Father & Mother (1 xerox)
- 6) Submission of an affidavit for those whose education has been interrupted in the previous academic session will be mandatory. (original copy)
- 7) Those who have participated in sports, cultural and art competitions or NCC/Scout Guide in class 10<sup>th</sup> should attach the respective certificate. (2 xerox)
- 8) Photocopy of BPL (Below Poverty Line) card holder (1 xerox)
- 9) If any kind of special reservation is taken while filling the online application form, it will be mandatory to submit the original document in that regard in 2 photocopies within the prescribed time limit.
- 10) Whose parents' income is Rs.1,00,000/- or less should attach the Income certificate obtained from Hon. Tehsildar. (1 xerox)
- 11) The college ID card sample form should be filled along with the admission form.
- 12) Two passport size photographs.

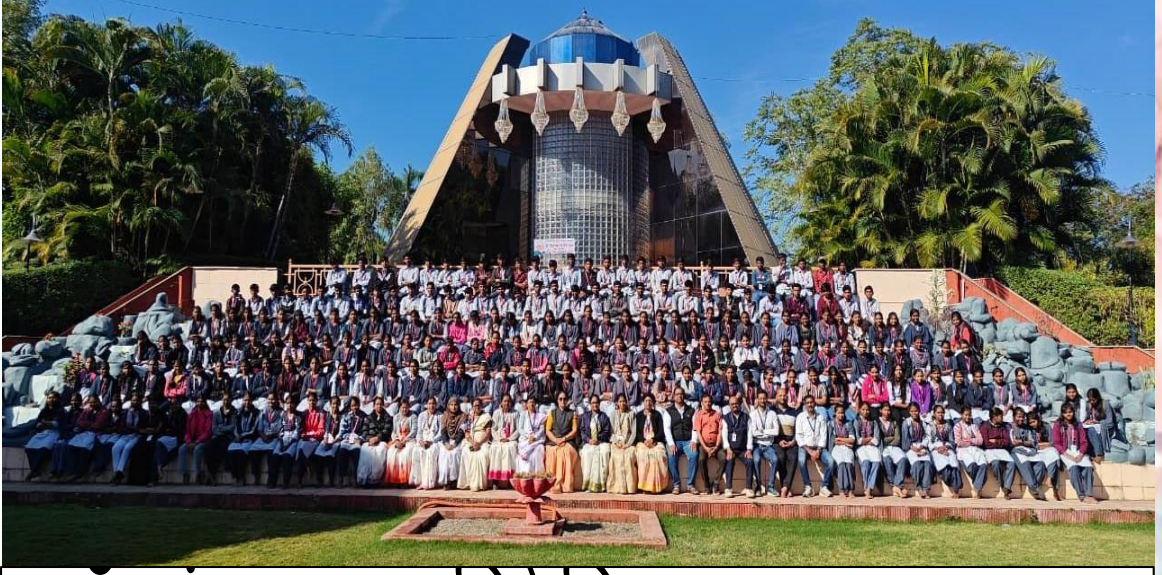



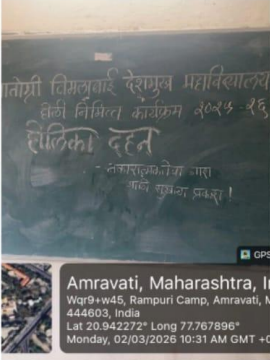
