Report

A NAAC sponsored one day National Seminar was organized by Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Matoshree Vimalabai Deshmukh Mahavidyalaya, Amravati under the theme “Role of NAAC in Quality Enhancement in Higher Education Institution (HEIs)” on 02nd March 2023. More than 150 Participants registered their names for the seminar. 28 authors wrote research articles for the proceeding.

The inaugural session was held at 11.00 am. The session started with the offering of floral tributes to the founder president of Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati, the great educationist and first Agriculture minister of India, Late Dr. Panjabrao alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh and his learned better half Late Matoshree Vimalabai Deshmukh. 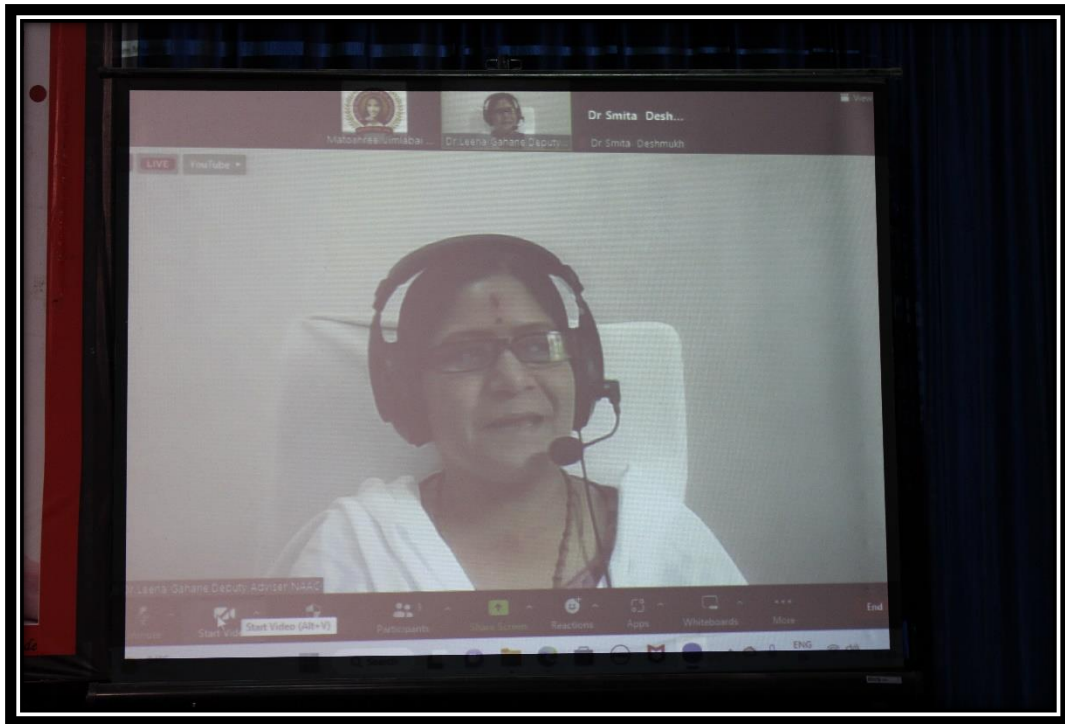

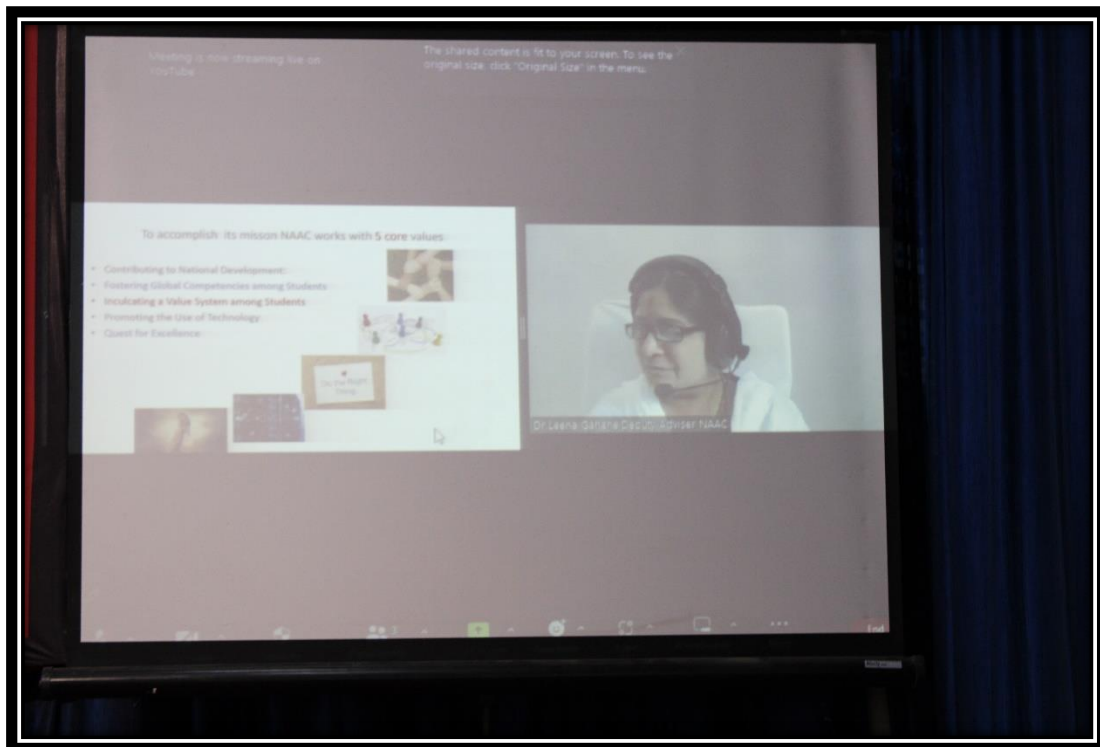
