

Founded in 1932 by Dr. Punjabrao Alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh, Shri Shivaji Education Society started its work by taking over Shri Shivaji Maratha High School and Shri Shivaji Maratha Hostel. Later, Bhausaheb took the initiative to start many schools, colleges and training centers under the institution. Today, the spread of this institution can be seen growing like a huge banyan tree. College Agricultural School, Village Servant Training Center, Extension Service Center, Hostels, Exercise School, Health Center, Printing Press, Swimming Pool and many other facilities are available. In all the districts of Vidarbha, this organization is working under the skillful and disciplined guidance of the President of the Society Hon'ble Mr. Harshvardhan P. Deshmukh.

The most proud thing is that Shree Shivaji Education society has been honored by the Government of Maharashtra with Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Dalit Mitra Award in 1993-94 and Gadge Maharaj Memorial Award in 1999-2000.On September 5, 2000, the Government of Maharashtra declared Shri Shivaji Education Society as the best administrative institution in Maharashtra with a prize of one lakh rupees and felicitated the society.

Also the Institute was selected for "Maharashtra Producer Award" by Social Science and Folklore Society Parbhani for 2010- 2011.

Regarding the continuation of "flag day" fund collection, on behalf of the government, the honorable president of the society was felicitated by the honorable chief minister.

In this way, the progress of the society to carry out quantitative and characteristic qualitative work in the educational sector and cultural sector is going on successfully.

Matoshree Vimalabai Deshmukh Mahavidyalay Amravati

According to the recommendations of the Dr. Sarvapalli Radhakrishnan Committee by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, 14 rural institutes were started in our country for the purpose of providing Rural Higher Education to the rural development sector. Among them, the Rural Institute Amravati was established by Shikshan Maharshi, late Bhausaheb Deshmukh, to his Shri Shivaji Education Society in 1956. Among the various courses introduced in this institute, Diploma in Rural Services was one of the major courses. Later, when this course was affiliated to Nagpur University, it came to be called B.A. (Rural Service) and thus a separate college named "College of Ruler Services" was started for B.A. (Ruler Services) course. Since the inception of Amravati University in 1983, the college has been affiliated to Amravati University, while the B.A.(Ruler Service) course has been converted into a traditional B.A.course from 1986-87.

B.Sc. (Home Science) and DBM courses were started in this college from 1983-84. Form 2016- 17 sessions, B.Sc. (Science) and B. Com. (English medium 2021-2022) Branches were started in the college on unaided basis. From 1991-1992 session Junior College Arts Branch was started and Commerce Science and Science Branch classes were started from 2006-2007 session. Also, from the session 2012-2013 unaided science classes have been started and now a total of eight classes are functioning. "Retail Management and Salesmanship", "Medical Lab Technician" and "Food Production Technology" branches were started from 1992-93 under minimum skill based vocational curriculum (H.S.C.V.C.).

Since 2nd September 1999, the name of College of Rural Services has been changed to the name of Late Vimalabai Deshmukh, the learned wife of Shikshan Maharshi Late Bhausaheb Deshmukh. Now this college is known as Matoshree Vimalabai Deshmukh College Amravati.

Admission Procedure:

- 1)Application in the prescribed form correctly filled and signed by applicant and his/her parent /Guardian and accompanied by two recent stamp size photographs and documents
- 2) The program for admission for the current session will be displayed on the notice board. Applicants are advised to keep the information of the various notices that are displayed on the notice board.
- 3) Admissions are subject to the eligibility Norms of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education and Sant Gadgebaba Amravati University Amravati.
- 4) The form must be received from the college office on or before the last date prescribed.
- 5) It must be accompanied by the attested copies of the following documents.
- i) School /College leaving Certificate (T. C.)
- II) Statement of Marks of the last Examination passed/failed.
- iii) Migration Certificate in Case of the Person who has passed the Last Examination from Other State Board or a University other than Gadgebaba Amravati University Amravati.
- iv) Cast, Validity and Non Creamy Layer Certificate.
- 6) Applicants will be required to surrender the original copy of their school /college leaving certificate at the time of finalization of admission.

- 7) Students who have passed the qualifying examination from any other Board/ University and desire to seek admission should submit an eligibility certificate.
- 8) Applicants who have a break in education should submit a gap certificate in the form of court affidavit stating the reason for the gap.
- 9) Duplicate transfer certificate (T. C.) will not be entertained
- 10) Admission will be provisional, subject to the approval of the University and liable to be cancelled at any time if the applicant has given false information or the University enrollment is not given to him / her.
- 11) All matters related to admission will be handled by admission committee during working hours as displayed on the notice board.
- 12) All the B. Sc. I and II students of this college are provisionally admitted to the next higher class subject to declaration of results. Mean while they should attend the classes regularly from June 10th 2022.

Important notice for students regarding financial concessions:

- A) 1) After taking admission, the application for the educational concessions for which you are eligible should be submitted to the office within 15 days along with the necessary documents.
- 2) Students who are eligible for the Government of India scholarship, must attach documents such as T.C., Mark sheet, Caste proof attested Xerox copy. Documents like Income proof of the same Tehsil in which the student is a resident, order number of scholarship taken earlier etc. are necessary to attached.
- 3) Income limit for scholarship eligible students in V. J., N.T., S. B. C., O. B. C. category is Rs.1 lakh.
- 4) Income limit for scholarship eligible students in S.C., S.T. category is Rs.2 lakh
- 5) Students who are eligible for the scholarship but whose income is more than Rs.1 lakh and Rs.2 lakh should fill the Free ship Scholarship Application Form.

- For O.B.C., S.B.C., V.J., N. T. students must attach the non-criminal certificate along with the free ship application along with the order number of the previous relaxation.
- 6) For students availing ABC concession, their father's income should not exceed Rs.1 lakh.
- 7) Students who are eligible for E.B.C. concession should attach two Xerox copies of front and back page of rationing card along with E.B.C. application and bring original rationing card for verification, otherwise E. B. C. application will not be accepted.
- 8) It is mandatory to attach the rationing card and Tehsil proof of the same address as the permanent address on the admission form of the students. If any discrepancy is found, the application will not be accepted.
- 9) Students should clearly note that 85% attendance is required from admission for Scholarship, E.B.C. or Free ship Scholarship. Students should clearly note that otherwise they will not be eligible for any of the above educational concessions.

B) Poor Student Fund:

Financial assistance will be provided to eligible students from this fund.

Instructions:

- 1) In case of any change in annual fee, Enrollment fee and other fees, such notification will be posted on the office bulletin and will have to be paid accordingly.
- 2) A full fee paying student will have to pay the full fee at the time of admission and E.B.C. And scholarship holders and other concession holders will have to pay other fees (which will not be available from the government) in time at the time of admission.
- 3) Apart from Sant Gadgebaba Amravati University, students of other Universities will have to pay Rs 100/- migration fee and Rs 100/- Continuity Fee after taking admission in this institute.

Identification card:

Every student admitted to the college must have an identity card which will be obtained from the library.

- A) Withdrawal and re-admission from college:
- 1) Students whose name will be withdrawn from the college for non-payment of tuition fees will have to re-pay the entire fee before re-admission.
- 2) The college reserves the right to recover the full fee from the student who leaves the college in the academic session.
- 3) A student appearing for the examination will have to pay the remaining fee in one installment before submitting the Sant Gadgebaba Amravati University examination application form without which he will not be allowed to appear for the examination.
- 4) Students seeking another original copy (Duplicate T. C.) of the college leaving certificate will have to pay a fee of Rs 100 and submit an affidavit stating that the original copy has been lost or burnt.

Medical checkup:

As per the rules of the University, the students will undergo a medical test once a year. This test is mandatory. Under no circumstances can a student miss this examination. Failure to appear in this test will result in a fine of 25 rupees.

Bicycle stand:

A bicycle stand has been arranged in the college and the students have to pay an annual fee of Rs.60 and keep the bicycle at the stand.

Sports department and physical education class:

Students get intensive marks for participating in various sports competitions

All the Pre-Graduate students are required to appear in the PT classes as per Sant Gadgebaba Amravati University rules and appear for the Physical Aptitude Test at the end of the year. Students who do not attend the class of PT and do not take the physical ability test will be fined Rs.25.

When there is an opportunity to participate in the competition organized by the sports department, the students must take advantage of this opportunity and gain proficiency.

Special Notice:

1) Absence of students from classes, absence from tests conducted by the college, damage to college furniture, experiment materials or other materials and disorderly behavior may be penalized to the students concerned, Students should take a clear note of this. It is compulsory for students to attend National events like 15 August, 26 January.

Intensive Marks:

Students participating in N.C.C. and donating blood will be responsible for bringing the certificate signed by the appropriate officer to the college office by the end of January for their participation in the relevant field. If no is brought, the student will be responsible for the damages.

Library Services:

The importance of the college library is unique to motivate the students to acquire the knowledge required for their future life. For this, the library service will be provided. The total collection of books in the Library is close to 26611. The collection of reference books like encyclopedias, biographies, directories, bibliographies on various subjects are available in the library.

The library can be used by the students as per the rules of the library.

Reading room:

The library has a separate reading room for the students and teachers and in this section magazines on various subjects as well as English and Marathi dailies are kept for reading.

Extracurricular activities:

Students are given the opportunity to develop their latent quality through various extra-curricular activities. Efforts are made to improve the quality of students through various activities such as Student council, Open dice, College Annual Issue "Gram Bharti" and "Annual gathering" etc.

National Service Scheme (N.S.S.):

The students who participate in this scheme get incentive marks. This college has two separate squad of National Service Scheme for male and female students., Everyone owes to the society. Therefore, under this scheme, the students should participate in the camps which are organized at different places during the year to do social service work.

Getting admission in the college should get the registration form from the professor in charge of the scheme and get the membership of the National Service Scheme.

Extension Services:

The college has established an extension work department and maintained contact with the rural sector, so that the students studying in the arts stream could be more attuned to the rural life.

It is expected to take advantage of the said department.

Student Consumer Cooperative Repository:

The college has started Student Consumer Co-operative Repository from the academic year 2003 - 2004.

Every student taking admission in the college will have to become a member of this cooperative Repository by paying a fee of Rs.10 and the share capital will be Rs.50. The main objective of this initiative is to provide students with various types of educational materials at affordable rates and to develop

cooperative and leadership qualities among the students. All students should take advantage of this opportunity.

Hostel: Hostel with all facilities:

The college has a new and modern independent hostel with all the facilities and discounts for the out-of-town female students studying in the college. Those students who want to get admission in this hostel should fix their admission within the time by filling the admission form duly and paying the fee as per the rules.

Sant Gadgebaba Amravati University Ordinance on Incentive Special Points Scheme: Notice:

The University has passed an Ordinance to provide incentive marks for college students of all branches for extra-curricular courses such as National Cadet Carps (N.C.C.), National Service Scheme (N. S.S.), Games and Sports and oratorical, Drama, Music Competitions etc.

The objective of this Ordinance is to encourage the student to participate more vigorously in the above-mentioned extracurricular program and to obtain more creditable marks in his examination mark sheet.

This estimate Ordinance has come into effect from Summer Examination 1986. A maximum of ten incentive marks are awarded to a student for one or all of these extracurricular programs directed above. Incentive marks are awarded by securing a maximum of five percent marks in one subject or all subjects below the pass mark and/or get credit in full marks.

Incentive marks for graduate students will be awarded as follows:

- 5 Marks

- b) Participation in National Service Scheme throughout the year (with one camp) 6 Marks
- c) Participation in National Service Scheme throughout the year (with two camp) 7 Marks
- 3) a) Participation in inter-collegiate sports competitions and matches at university level- 3 Marks (each one)
- b) Participation in inter-university sports competitions and matches-3 Marks (each one)
- 4) a) Participation in Inter College Cultural Competitions recognized by the University. (Debate. / Drama / Music etc.) -3 Marks (each one)
- b) Participation in inter-university level and above mentioned cultural competitions- 5 Marks (each one)
- 5) Every time a blood donation is made 2 Marks (Maximum 5 Marks)
- 6) Involvement in compilation of statistical material required under Government schemes. 5 Marks
- 7) Home Guard:
- a) Participation in the Home Guard Force.-3 Marks
- b) Participation in the Home Guard Force (with camp) 5 Marks

College Rules:

- 1) Check the notice board daily and note the instructions on it.
- 2) Handle books and books in the library properly and do not damage them.
- 3) It will not be mandatory to inform parents about absence from college. Parents should get information about these themselves.
- 4) Activities such as extension work, national service scheme, games and sports, Annual gathering, and hostel days should be made a success.
- 5) If the professor of a subject is on leave, visit the library during such hours.
- 6) For the proper guidance, meet the concerned professors in charge and contact the Principal and Office.
- 7) Attend the program organized by the college.
- 8) It is mandatory for every student to behave in a disciplined manner by following the rules approved by the college. A student should maintain good behavior while in college. An unruly student will be ordered to leave the college. It will be binding on him.
- 9) Nothing should be written on the college building. Do not paste posters and stickers. Do not damage the building in any way and do not damage the property. Otherwise individual or collective fine will be imposed. No complaint will be heard about it.
- 10) Students should not bring unauthorized persons into the college premises. Strict action will be taken if brought.
- 11) Every student must carry the identity card issued by the college in the college premises and produce it immediately on demand for inspection. He will not be admitted to the library and reading room or elsewhere without an identity card.
- 12) No waste paper or waste should be thrown in the college premises.
- 13) The final decision on whether or not to organize the annual convocation of the college will be taken by the principal of the college and that decision will be binding on all.

14) If the annual gathering is organized, it will be held in the last week of December.

The final decision regarding the format, time and duration of the annual gathering will remain with the Principal. The program of the gathering will normally end by 6 pm.

- 15) If the students want to organize any educational and similar program, they have to take the written permission of the principal. If the program is held without it, action will be taken against the concerned student.
- 16) Students of the college shall not collect any kind of funds from each other without the prior permission of the principal of the college.
- 17) During college classes, students should not sit on the veranda in front of the classroom or wander around unnecessarily from the veranda. Also, do not linger in the college premises without work. Violation of these rules will be penalized by the Principal.
- 18) Students of the college cannot invite any outsider without the prior permission of the Principal while organizing any program.
- 19) Apart from the educational trips included in the curriculum, the trips of the students of the college may not be taken in the academic session. However, trips can be made through the teacher concerned during holidays or periods without interrupting the work of teaching. If all these types of trips are to be organized, the written permission of the Principal will be mandatory.
- 20) Students are not allowed to keep their bicycles or scooters anywhere other than the bicycle shed in the college premises.

Otherwise disciplinary action will be taken.

- 21) Bringing and using mobile phones in the college premises will be prohibited.
- 22) The uniform prescribed by the college should be used.
- 23) Students taking admission in senior colleges should accept the membership of the student organization of the college.

Special notice to students regarding ragging:

In order to prevent the unfortunate occurrence of ragging in any colleges in the future, the Government has enacted the Anti-Ragging Maharashtra Prevention of Ragging Act 1999 (Act No. 33 of 99).

Meaning of the term ragging - Exhibits misbehavior or commits any such act which causes or is likely to cause physical or mental harm to a student in any educational institution or causes him to feel fear or dread or embarrassment or Or there is a feeling of being in trouble.

And that includes the following-

A) Teasing, abusing, threatening, or playing pranks or saying hurtful words on such a student.

Or

- B) Asking such student to do an act or thing which he would not ordinarily do academically.
- * Ragging is prohibited in or outside any educational institution.
- * Whoever directly or indirectly participates in, encourages or promotes ragging in or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to 02 years and with fine which may extend to 10,000/- rupees.

Besides that, the offending student will be expelled from the college or institution and he will not get admission in any other colleges or institute for five years.

Students are requested not to engage in such misbehavior.
